

Re: Age restrictions / limitations for shooting

Per New York State Law...

Long guns... No person under the age of 12 can legally possess or discharge a long gun in New York State.

Pistols... Minimum legal age to handle a pistol in New York at this time is 14. However, it is against the law for anyone between the ages of 14 - 21 to handle a pistol without a certified instructor present.

Also... **as a reminder it is against the law to "bring a friend to the range" and allow that friend to shoot your pistol unless your friend has a New York State Pistol Permit.**

There are similar rules for youngsters that may want to hunt. For specifics, you should attend one of the clubs' hunters safety courses !!!!
