

## VIDEO SYSTEM FAQ

- Why was a video system installed?  
Liability protection against accident, theft, non-member incidences.  
Addresses safety issues as well as providing insurance advantages.
- How does the system work?  
Nine cameras placed at strategic locations record and save the video digitally.
- What is being monitored?  
Both floors of the clubhouse and the immediate exterior property.
- What about the restrooms?  
The men's rooms are not in the video view field. The ladies room upstairs has a digital block (a black box) over the door. Of course, simply closing the door affords the most privacy.
- Am I being watched all the time?  
Live view is available but typically is unmonitored. The footage will be reviewed in the event of an incidence.
- What happens with the saved video?  
The video is saved for approximately a week and then overwritten. Video will be retained if a situation warrants it.
- Does it record when it's dark?  
Yes, using infrared
- Does the system record sound?  
It has the capability but has not been implemented.
- Who has access to recorded video?  
It is in a secure area so whoever has access (primarily board members) can view the live feed.  
Access to the system functions is by password. If a member would like a demo it can be arranged.
- How was this funded?  
It was part of the 2017 budget which was voted on at the January monthly meeting.
- Are there any monthly costs associated with this system?  
No
- Is the gun range getting monitors?  
A plan has been established for future enhancement but is not funded.
- When will the installation be complete?  
Should be wrapped on March 30, 2017.
